

When The server receives e-mail to addresses that don't exist, it has to do something with those messages. The control panel gives you three options:

- 1. Server deletes message and notifies sender that the address doesn't exist.
- 2. Server deletes message without notifying sender.
- 3. Server forwards the message to a valid e-mail address.

To choose between these options, first access the "Advanced Features" from the control panel. Then, click the "Catch-All E-Mail" link. You will see something like this:





Fail:	The sender is notified that the address doesn't exist ?
Ignore:	The e-mail is dropped and completely ignored ?
Address:	feedback@site-helper.com

Choose the desired option and click "Save."

 $\textbf{Note:} \ \ \textbf{Do} \ \ \textbf{NOT} \ \ \textbf{choose} \ \ \text{``Ignore:''} \ \ \textbf{option} \ \ \textbf{unless you} \ \ \textbf{know} \ \ \textbf{what you} \ \ \textbf{are doing.} \ \ \textbf{Abusing '`Ignore:''} \ \ \textbf{option} \ \ \textbf{can slow} \ \ \textbf{down your server.}$
